Inclusive Teaching and Learning (ITL)



DATE: 5TH - 30TH SEPTEMBER 2022

This course highlights the skills, attitudes and values that teachers need in order to develop as effective practitioners, able to support learners with diverse needs. It takes as a starting point the fact that inclusive teaching is the responsibility of all teachers, not just those with special training, and draws heavily on the UNICEF 'wave model' for inclusive education. The course is practice-focused, and task-based giving participants the opportunity to apply new concepts to their own teaching and to reflect on their practice with other participants. The tasks encourage participants to draw on their own experience and plan for their own development as an inclusive teacher. They will be encouraged to collaborate with others on course forums and in their workplace, and there will be opportunity to assimilate new learning and apply the ideas to practice settings. The course will leave participants with a 'toolkit' of resources and ideas that will support their further development.
